Washington School Improvement Framework (WSIF)

The Washington School Improvement Framework (WSIF) identifies how schools can improve the education of all students. The Framework combines the following indicators into a 1-10 score:

- ELA Proficiency
- Math Proficiency
- ELA Growth
- Math Growth
- Regular Attendance
- Ninth Grade On Track Measure
- English Language Progress
- Dual Credit
- Graduation
- Extra Credit for Graduation



Washington School Improvement Framework (WSIF)


How are indicators combined to create an Overall Framework Score?

- Indicators are combined to create a composite school score
- Each indicator is mapped to a 1-10 score
- These scores are combined based on the grade span of the school, creating the Framework
- Any school under the established threshold will be identified for <u>comprehensive</u> <u>support</u>, and any school with a student group under the threshold will be identified for <u>targeted support</u>.

 - Hathaway




WSIF Building Data for Canyon Creek Middle School




Smarter Balanced - ELA




Smarter Balanced - Math



Smarter Balanced - Science




Smarter Balanced Assessment - Foundational Knowledge Changes with OSPI Reporting 2023-24 Data





Student Attendance




- Engage parents as partners encouraging regular attendance


Student Discipline




- Historical focus on middle schools

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Student Discipline by Race/Ethnicity




Graduation Rate




- 4.4% of the WHS

Graduation Rate by Race/Ethnicity




Advanced Placement
